A tenants association is a union of all or most of the tenants in a building. When we work together, we can apply more pressure to make a landlord provide services, make repairs, and stop harassment—and get the best possible home. A strong tenant association can force our landlord to listen; as a group, we have more power to negotiate, file complaints with the city and state agencies that oversee housing, get help from elected officials, go to court, or—if push comes to shove—call a rent strike.
